GROWING IN COMMUNITY

- You'll have a mentor in the congregation. This is an adult member of you UUCP (someone other than your parent), who will help guide you through the process
- You'll have the COA facilitators. Your facilitators will support you in reflecting on your experiences, writing your credo, and creating the COA service.
- Most importantly, you'll have each other! Your cohort will be grouped by age and you'll have a team of voyagers to explore with.

Unit 1: Introductions

Unit 2: Exposure

Autumn

Ask big questions about yourself! Maybe even find some answers. What spiritual practices matter to you? Why do you choose to do good in the world? Why do you get to be part of the universe???? What did the universe ever do for you?

Youth also inspire and challenge the adult members of the church to examine their own spiritual values. We have an obligation to offer meaningful, faith-based preparation for this huge lifestage transition between childhood and youth, between "no longer but not yet."
